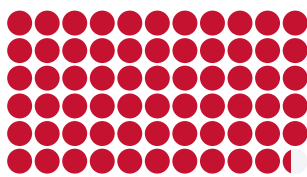

For every \$1...



Students gain **\$4.70** in lifetime earnings



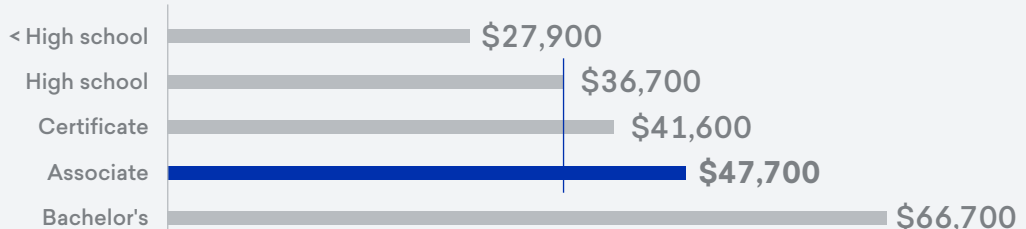
Taxpayers gain **\$2.50** in added tax revenue and public sector savings



Society gains **\$9.50** in added income and social savings



The average associate degree graduate from CCAC will see an increase in earnings of **\$11,000** each year compared to someone with a high school diploma or equivalent working in Pennsylvania.
